
Students Mastering Important Lifeskills Education

Focusing on Child Protection-Good Touch/Bad Touch (Child abuse prevention), Responsible Behavior, Gender Equality, Physiology and Anatomy (8th Std Onwards) and HIV/AIDS – (Information for 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Std only).

Special Sessions with Parents on issues of their children primarily in the area of Gender, Sexuality, Responsible behavior, Mass Media impact and Substance Abuse, these sessions are conducted after each students sessions as part of feedback and developing a cohesive action plan in partnership with Teachers





HAI – Healthy Adolescent Initiative

~ A strategic alliance between Health Care Providers and Adolescent children for providing health linkages that are of high Quality and moreover Consistent Health Care. The project is to streamline the health care access of the under privileged, marginalized adolescents in 53 schools of 'E' ward of Brihan Mumbai Mahanagar Palika (BMC) high schools by way of quarterly health check up in an academic year.

We also work with 158 Private Shools in Mumbai, Navi Mumbai and Thane to work with them in the area of Malnutrition, ENT and Pediatric- Heart Care and Diabetes






Students Mastering Important Life Skills Education (SMILE) Program- Conducted In BMC Schools For Underprivileged Adolescents.
